MOTION TO VACATE TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

The defendant, William B. Coleman (“Mr. Coleman”), through his undersigned counsel, hereby moves the court to vacate its order dated January 23, 2008 and articulated in a memorandum of decision dated May 21, 2008 (the “Order”), in which the Court granted a temporary injunction (the “Injunction”) providing the plaintiff, Theresa Lantz (“Plaintiff”), the authority to force feed hunger striking prisoner, William B. Coleman.

As is set forth more fully in the memorandum of law submitted herewith, the Injunction should be vacated because there is no longer a danger of irreparable and imminent injury and because Plaintiff is unlikely to prevail on the merits in this litigation. Indeed, the factual grounds on which the temporary injunction was based no longer exist. Moreover, allowing the temporary injunction to remain in place and providing Plaintiff with the ability to force feed Mr. Coleman against his will impermissibly violates Mr. Coleman’s fundamental rights to privacy under Connecticut common law and United States Constitution Amendment XIV and free speech rights under the Connecticut Constitution, Article I, §§ 4, 5, and 14 and under the United States Constitution, Amendments I and XIV.

WHEREFORE, the defendant, William B. Coleman, respectfully requests that this Court grant this motion and vacate the Injunction.


