


STIPULATED AGREEMENT

The State of Connecticut (hereinafter referred to as the "State"), acting through the Office of Labor Relations (hereinafter referred to as "OLR"), and Joseph Marie (hereinafter referred to as "Mr. Marie") hereby agree as follows:

1. Mr. Marie has indicated a desire to voluntarily resign from state service for personal reasons in lieu of dismissal. Mr. Marie shall be deemed to have resigned in good standing effective close of business, July 29, 2010 from his position as the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation.
2. Mr. Marie shall immediately return to the State any and all property of the State of Connecticut, including, but not limited to the state car, blackberry or other PDA, computer(s), state, Bradley Airport and rail identification cards, gasoline credit card, keys or access cards to any state building or equipment, VPN card and air card.
3. Mr. Marie shall not contact any current or former employee of the Department of Transportation or State of Connecticut, except as specifically authorized by the Office of the Governor's Legal Counsel.
4. Mr. Marie shall not have access to any State building or facility effective immediately. He shall be accompanied by a state trooper to retrieve his personal belongings from his office at the Department of Transportation on July 2, 2010. Mr. Marie will be contacted to determine a mutually convenient time for such purpose.
5. In consideration of this agreement, Mr. Marie agrees that he has not been discriminated against in any way including, but not limited to discrimination which falls under the jurisdiction of the CHRO or EEOC. This agreement resolves all outstanding issues involving Mr. Marie and extinguishes any and all claims he may have.
6. In signing this Agreement, Mr. Marie acknowledges that he freely and voluntarily enters into this Agreement without duress, intimidation, undue influence or any threatened loss of benefit. Mr. Marie acknowledges that he has read it and fully understands its contents, meaning, intent and implications.


7. Mr. Marie agrees not to file or pursue any legal action against the State of Connecticut, its representatives, or its employees in any forum as a result of this Agreement. The above consideration is all that Mr. Marie will receive for all potential claims and causes of action. No promise has been made to Mr. Marie by anyone for any further relief.
8. In the event Mr. Marie in any way criticizes, verbally or in writing, the Governor of the State of Connecticut or any member of the administration or employee of the State of Connecticut, such resignation in good standing shall be changed to a dismissal indicating that the services of Mr. Marie no longer pleased the Governor due to inappropriate behavior by Mr. Marie.
